HAUT DE SENAUX PINOT ROSE



APPELLATION : IGP Pays d'Oc



GRAPE VARIETY : Pinot noir



TERROIR : Vineyards planted on clay-gravel soils.



VINIFICATION AND AGEING :

Night mechanical harvest with immediate separation of juices and berries. Pneumatic pressing at low pressure then alcoholic fermentation in concrete tank under regulated temperature.

TASTING :



COLOR : Beautiful salmon pink colour with silver reflections.

NOSE : Fruity on small crushed strawberries that reveal delicate vanilla scents.

PALATE : Fresh and thirst-quenching attack, the mouth announces a delicate wine on fresh fruit notes. The tense finish confirms all the refreshing features of this wine.



MATCHING WINE & FOOD:

This wine gives its best when served with grilled fish, summer salad.



OENOLOGIST'S ADVICE:

This cooler-than-usual vintage gave the pinot grape a more typical character.
